TRAIL RIDE RULES:

OBEY TRAIL BOSS AND SCOUTS! All dogs must be on a leash & may not run loose. No riding bareback, trick riding or roping. No littering, cursing or fighting. No firearms and no alcohol on horseback. Uncontrollable horses are not allowed on the ride. **Red ribbons** will be furnished for horses that kick. Children must be accompanied by an adult. **Generators should be of reasonable noise level.** Do not play loud music when staying up late. The purpose of the rescue trailer is to transport an injured horse and/or rider. If you desire to ride only a partial day, either due to stamina of rider or horse, the rider must make their individual arrangements for transport.
